Role Description:

- The Assembly Setup Operator works closely with the Assembly Team Leader in overseeing all assembly tooling and equipment, set-up related processes, equipment tear downs, adjustments and minor troubleshooting based on the needs of the manufacturing process
- Assisting the Assembly Team Leader in maintaining high level of organization of tooling/fixtures and equipment used on the assembly floor, ensuring record keeping of all tooling, while monitoring aging of the tooling to ensure timely preventative maintenance or re-ordering when needed
- Informing Assembly Team Leader of any part or equipment defects to ensure prompt response to the problem
- Working collaboratively with QC/Inspection department in performing First-offs, makes running adjustments to equipment units when needed to ensure manufacturing specifications are met
- Successful candidates require previous experience performing setups on small custom tooling/equipment within a manufacturing environment and good working knowledge of schematics
- Ability to commit to flexible schedule and prompt arrival for shifts
- Perform other duties as required
